RE:NEW - Homes in West London to Become More Energy Efficient

Homes in Brent, Ealing, Harrow, Hillingdon and Hounslow will be among those next to benefit from the RE:NEW, the Mayor of London's domestic energy efficiency improvement programme.

RE:NEW is a pan-London scheme designed to improve energy efficiency in London's housing stock. It aims to reduce fuel bills for residents, help tackle fuel poverty for lower income households and reduce the environmental impact of heating London's 3.2 million homes. The programme is funded by the Mayor and all 32 London boroughs have signed as partners in the scheme, which is being delivered in partnership with London Councils and the Energy Saving Trust.
